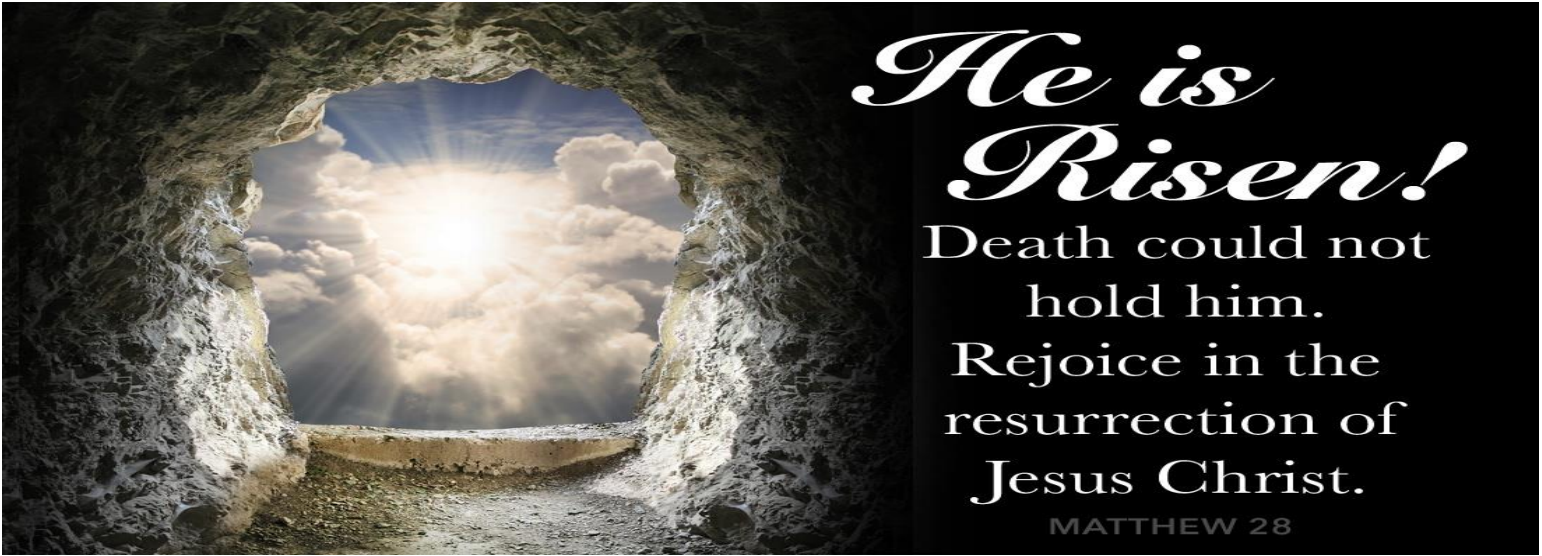
For the Sick and Homebound:
