 Please call the church office if you would like to receive communion or have home visits.

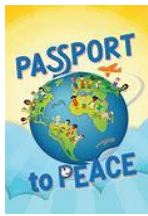
Confessions:

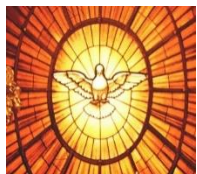
