Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time



Ash Wednesday Mass will be held on **Wednesday March 5th @ 12:00pm and 6:00pm**. Lenten dinners will begin this coming Friday, March 7th after the 6:00pm Stations. Donations are welcome. Stations will continue each Friday throughout Lent.

Fasting and Abstinence- Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. The norms of fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59 unless pregnant, breastfeeding, mental or physical illnesses prevent you from doing so.

Abstinence- Abstinence refers to refraining from eating meat as a form of penance or spiritual sacrifice. This helps Catholics to practice a form of self-discipline in imitation of Christ's sacrifice.



Disaster Fund- There is a special collection being held for disaster relief to support the recovery efforts across the Mountain State after the severe flooding resulting in loss of life, property, and livelihood. More than ten counties in our state remain under a State of Emergency. The money raised will remain in WV to be managed by Catholic Charities West Virginia and will be allocated using a four-tier priority list. Checks should be made out to St. Ann Catholic Parish with "Disaster Relief" on the memo line.
